IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ARTWORK

- All art work must be original conception, designed and executed by the accepted artisan.
- NO commercial molds, patterns, pre-strung beads, kits, buy-sell or resale items.
- NO commercially cast jewelry, etc., or purchased items. This includes imported goods. Jewelers must be the designers and hands-on makers of their work. Purchased, facet cut gems may be used. Assembled, prefabricated jewelry is not allowed.
- Artisans will exhibit only the accepted medium.
- Suspect items will be examined and reviewed utilizing web and current craft publications to ensure ORIGINAL WORK.
- All work must be suitable for an art festival.
- **Understand that failure to follow the guidelines and rules stated can mean IMMEDIATE EXPULSION from this year's art festival and future festivals.**

JURIED SHOW

- All work submitted will be juried for acceptance into the festival.
- Entries are NOT judged according to date received but by the quality of the work to be exhibited.
- No artists accepted on day of the festival.
- NO BUY/SELL MERCHANDISE.
- **All jewelry applications will be juried for acceptance on June 30. Any jewelry application received after that date will only be accepted should there be a jewelry cancellation.**

ENTRY

- Submit at least five photos: 3 photos of art work, 1 photo displaying artwork in production stage and 1 photo of booth with artwork displayed.
- Artist's name and art work description must be included with photos. Please, no slides.
- Photos must represent the type of items actually being sold.
- Acceptance into the show is contingent upon completion of this application and selection process. Your completed application is considered a commitment to the show. If not accepted, your entry booth fee will be mailed back to you with your pictures. Any cancellations after work is accepted and booth fee is processed will result in a 100% forfeiture of fees.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Non-refundable Application Fee: \$10 (check or money order payable to CTPR or fill in credit card information)

BOOTH FEE (check/money order/CC)

- \$150 per single booth space (12 x 12) \$160 after 7/28/17
- \$275 per double booth space (24 x 12) \$285 after 7/28/17
- A \$25 insufficient funds penalty will be charged for any returned checks.

COMMISSION/TAX

- Artist is responsible for MI state sales tax.
- NO COMMISSION

DISPLAY

- Each booth space is 12 x 12.
- Clean white tents only.
- All booths and their contents (table, chairs, shelves, tents, etc. and power if required) must be furnished by the artists, be able to withstand crowds and weather, and fit within the 12 x 12 booth space.
- Generators by permit only.
- Merchandise may be brought in by dolly, handtruck, wagon or vehicle prior to show. No vehicles will be permitted in the exhibit area after set up or before closing of the show.
- Artists may not sublet or apportion space to anyone.
- A fire extinguisher is required for those with products that use a heating device or open flame of any kind.

DEMONSTRATIONS

- Ongoing demonstrations are encouraged.

WAITING LIST POLICY

- Artists who have been placed on a waiting list are categorized by media, but not listed in any specific order. When a cancellation is received, the Committee refers to that list and when possible, chooses a replacement from the same category. An artist will be contacted if they are chosen from the waiting list as a replacement.

ARTIST BOOTHS MUST REMAIN OPEN FOR THE DURATION OF THE FESTIVAL, RAIN OR SHINE

- Artist must be set up and ready to sell from 10 am to 5 pm
- Artists leaving the festival prior to the end will be barred from exhibition in future festivals.
